## MINUTES OF TOWN COUNCIL MEETING

**March 24, 2003**

An open and public meeting, posted pursuant to the open meetings law, was held on Monday, March 24, 2003, at 6:00 p.m., in the Town of Sharpsburg at the Bridges Recreation Center.

Present were the following: David Mullins, Mayor Pro-Tem; Derrick McElwaney, Council Member; Wendell Staley, Council Member; Robin Spradlin, Town Clerk; David P. Winkle, Town Attorney.

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss potential annexation by legislative act. Mayor Mullins stated he had met with Representative Lynn Westmoreland to discuss amending the Town's Charter to increase the boundaries of the Town Limits.

Initially, Council discussed increasing the northern boundary line to reflect a 1.25 mile radius from the .5 mile radius. After further discussion, it was decided to investigate the possibility of extending the northern radius to the existing semi-perimeter created by Marion Beavers, Willis and Reese Roads.

Further discussion concluded it will be necessary to determine and document if the proposed annexation area is less than 50% residential. Council Member McElwaney and Clerk Spradlin to research and report back to Council.

No action was taken during meeting. Meeting was adjourned.
