

**TOWN OF SHARPSBURG
MINUTES OF THE TOWN COUNCIL MEETING**

September 8, 2003

A regular meeting of the Sharpsburg Town Council was held Monday, September 8, 2003, at 7:00 p.m., in the Town of Sharpsburg at the Bridges Recreation Center.

Present were the following: Wendell Staley, Mayor ; Clay Cole, Council Member; Larry Hyde, Council Member; Derrick McElwaney, Council Member; Robin Spradlin, Town Clerk.

Mayor Staley called the meeting to order.

The minutes of the meetings of Council held on August 4 and August 27, 2003, were reviewed and approved by unanimous vote, and were filed in the minute book of the Town.

Paul Muldawer and David B. Lackey of Muldawer Associates appeared before Council to present a proposal for town planning and design for Sharpsburg. The project would include a Master Town Plan and Comprehensive Plan utilizing smart growth and traditional neighborhood development zoning. No action was taken.

Mayor Staley called for second reading and adoption of the Ordinance for Property Taxes. Council Member Cole motioned to adopt and enact said Ordinance. Council Member McElwaney seconded. Motion carried, unanimously.

Mayor Staley called for first reading of an Ordinance for Vehicle Size Restrictions. Copies of Ordinance were previously presented to Council and were available for inspection by public. Council Member McElwaney explained that Terrentine Street needed to be clarified as on some maps it extends onto Sharpsburg-McCollum Road. Council Member McElwaney motioned to accept Ordinance for first reading with the before mentioned change. Council Member Hyde seconded. Motion carried, unanimously.

Council Member Hyde motioned to approve and execute the DOT Local Assistance Road Program contract LAU00-S005-00-(471) for the resurfacing of Terrentine Street. Council Member Cole seconded. Motion carried, unanimously.

Council Member Cole motioned to appoint Standly David Parten as Council Member to fill the remainder (less than one year) of the term of office recently vacated by David Mullins. Council Member Hyde seconded. Motion carried, unanimously.

After being duly sworn, Clerk Robin Spradlin administered the oath of office to Stan Parten.

There being no further business to come before the Council, the meeting was adjourned.
