

**TOWN OF SHARPSBURG  
MINUTES OF THE TOWN COUNCIL MEETING**

**November 3, 2003**

A regular meeting of the Sharpsburg Town Council was held Monday, November 3, 2003, at 7:00 p.m., in the Town of Sharpsburg at the Bridges Recreation Center.

Present were the following: Wendell Staley, Mayor ; Clay Cole, Council Member; Larry Hyde, Council Member; Derrick McElwaney, Council Member; Stan Parten, Council Member; Robin Spradlin, Town Clerk.

Mayor Staley called the meeting to order.

The minutes of the Public Hearings and meetings of Council listed below were reviewed and approved as written by unanimous vote, and were filed in the minute book of the Town.

Mayor Staley informed the Council that he had met with representatives from Sharpsburg Baptist Church regarding their request to install lighting fixtures. They plan to install seven 125 watt high pressure sodium bulbs on 17' poles in the parking lots to the church. Mayor also stated that he had reviewed the specs for the lighting including the illumination areas and felt that the lights would not pose a problem for citizens or passing traffic. Council Member McElwaney motioned to approve lighting request. Council Member Cole seconded. Motion carried, unanimously.

Council discussed the resurfacing of Terrentine and the fact that the County will not assist with the LARP project unless the speed bumps are removed from Terrentine Street. Several citizens complained that the speed bumps are needed and do not need to be removed. Council Member Parten motioned to remove and not replace the speed bumps along Terrentine Street and request the Coweta County Public Works Department to proceed with the project. Council Member McElwaney seconded. Motion carried, unanimously.

Mayor Staley presented Council with Resolution for application for a Quality Growth Grant to assist with Town planning. Town Clerk stated that Nancy Seegar had sent a draft of the grant application to DCA for preliminary review and had received a

favorable response. Council Member Hyde motioned to approve resolution to submit application for the Quality Growth Grant. Council Member Cole seconded. Motion carried, unanimously.

Mayor Staley called for second reading of update to Moratorium on Rezoning and Building Permits. The amended Ordinance provides for a review of progress approximately every ninety days. After public review, the moratorium may be extended by resolution. Council Member Hyde motioned to adopt and enact said ordinance. Council Member Parten seconded. Motion carried, unanimously.

Mayor Staley polled Council for any input from citizens. Council Member Hyde said he is still getting complaints from residents regarding the paving of Stovall Street. Mayor Staley indicated he had talked with legislators regarding this issue and hoped we would be able to move forward in the near future.

There being no further business to come before the Council, the meeting was adjourned.
