MINUTES OF PUBLIC HEARINGS

The purpose of the Public Hearing was to solicit public comment on a Fiscal Year 2003 Budget Amendment Resolution and the Fiscal Year 2004 Proposed Budget for the General and SPLOST Funds.

The Public Hearing was called to order at 7:00pm.

Mayor Staley explained that the first hearing was to receive comment on an amendment to the 2003 Budget. There were no public questions or comments. Mayor Staley closed public hearing on 2003 Budget Amendment Resolution.

Mayor Staley explained that the second hearing was to receive comment on the proposed 2004 Proposed Budget. Several citizens asked general questions. The only recommended change was on the line item description for Solid Waste Collection on the Expenditure Budget. The description should read "For all non-commercial residents January thru December."
