

**TOWN OF SHARPSBURG  
MINUTES OF THE TOWN COUNCIL MEETING**

**June 2, 2008**

A regular meeting of the Sharpsburg Town Council was held Monday, June 2, 2008, at 7:00pm, in the Town of Sharpsburg at the Bridges Recreation Center.

Present were the following: Derrick McElwaney, Mayor; Polly Garlington, Council Member; Connie Turner, Council Member and Donna Camp, Town Clerk. Council Members Rhodes and Anderson were absent.

Also in attendance were Boy Scout Troop #46, Gwen Lyons and Herb Bridges.

Mayor McElwaney called the meeting to order and the Pledge of Allegiance was delivered.

The Town Clerk verified there was a quorum present.

The minutes of the Council Meeting held on May 5, 2008 were reviewed and approved.

Dr. Matthew Davis addressed the Mayor and Council about Kids Day America/International.
