

**TOWN OF SHARPSBURG
MINUTES OF THE TOWN COUNCIL MEETING**

December 7, 2009

A regular meeting of the Sharpsburg Town Council was held Monday, December 7, 2009, at 7:15pm, in the Town of Sharpsburg at the Bridges Recreation Center.

Present were the following: Derrick McElwaney, Mayor; Keith Rhodes, Council Member; Connie Turner, Council Member and Donna Camp, Town Clerk. Council Member Anderson was absent.

Also in attendance were: Celene Davenport, Dillon Davenport, Wendell & Margaret Staley and Polly Garlington.

Mayor McElwaney called the meeting to order and the Pledge of Allegiance was delivered.

The Town Clerk verified there was a quorum present.

The minutes of the November 9, 2009 Council Meeting were reviewed and approved as written by unanimous vote, and were filed in the minute book of the Town.

Polly Garlington presented a slide show in rebuttal to the comments of the Mayor at the November Council Meeting. Mayor McElwaney stated that the Committee was instilled under the previous administration and had completed the tasks that were put before them.

Council Member Rhodes motioned to adopt the resolution amending the fiscal year 2009 budget as proposed by the Finance Committee. Council Member Turner seconded. Motion carried unanimously.
