

**TOWN OF SHARPSBURG
MINUTES OF THE TOWN COUNCIL MEETING**

October 2, 2017

A regular scheduled meeting of the Sharpsburg Town Council was held Monday, October 2, 2017, at 6:00pm, at the Sharpsburg Recreation Center.

Present were the following: Wendell Staley, Mayor; Stan Parten, Council Member; Clay Cole, Council Member; Polly Garlington, Council Member; Donna Camp, Town Clerk. Council Member Rhodes was absent.

The Pledge of Allegiance was delivered.

The Clerk verified there was a quorum present.

The minutes of the August 7, 2017 Council Meeting were reviewed and approved by unanimous vote, and were filed in the minute book of the Town.

Mayor Staley called for a motion to approve appointing the Mayor to be a voting member of the newly formed Coweta County Joint Transportation Coordination Committee. Per the bylaws of the committee, the council needs to approve the appointment. Council Member Garlington motioned, Council Member Cole seconded. Motion carried by show of hands, unanimously.

Mayor Staley called for a motion to approve moving forward with the land swap on the Hwy. 54 (tank property) with Mr. Diaz. It would be a small boundary swap that would give the town an additional 30' highway frontage and give Mr. Diaz more room on the back of his property for his garage entrance. There will be no monetary cost for the swap other than the legal fees to close the deal. Council Member Cole motioned, Council Member Parten seconded. Motion carried by show of hands, unanimously. Old Business -
